Capital Improvement Program: PHL has undergone more than \$2 billion in capital improvements since 2000.

Major Construction Projects:

- Terminal A-East Improvements: \$82.3 million, completed 2014
- Runway 9L/27R rehabilitation: \$ 1.8 million, completed 2015
- Taxiway K extension: \$19.7 million, completed 2015
- Terminal F Expansion: \$162 million, completed 2016

- Terminal D/E improvements: estimated \$367 million
- Runway 9R/27L extension and associated taxiway and infrastructure work: estimated \$202.8 million
