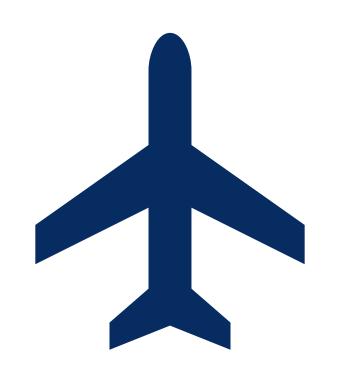


#### PHL Access for All program

# When you leave Security, you will walk down long hallways to get to your gate.






### The Airport will be bright, noisy, and may be crowded.





## There is one hallway that connects all the terminals.






### You can ask for a Hidden Disability Sunflower Lanyard from an information booth once you are past security.






### You will find information booths in every Terminal.






#### There is a quiet room on the D/E Connector.








Animals have their own bathrooms in the Airport.
