5. Prohibited Items in Restricted Areas of the Airport

- a. Those persons entering or who are within the Restricted Area may not possess or carry any items, (except liquids and gels that are allowed through employee access points), that the TSA prohibits from carriage through Screening Checkpoints or in carry-on luggage unless those items are required for job-related activities.
- b. A list of items prohibited by the TSA, including, but not limited to, sharp objects; sporting goods; guns and firearms; martial arts and self defense items; tools; explosive materials, flammable items and disabling chemicals or other dangerous items, is available on the TSA website at <u>www.tsa.gov</u>. The TSA will update the prohibited items list from time to time as necessary.
- c. Those who possess or carry items otherwise prohibited by the TSA into or within the Restricted Area for job related purposes, particularly tools relating to authorized construction projects, are prohibited from leaving

said items unattended unless they are secured in a room or storage area inaccessible to screened passengers.

d. Violators will be fined a minimum of \$100.00 and their access privileges may be suspended or permanently revoked depending on the severity of the incident.
