Call Ahead

Travelers may call TSA Cares toll-free 72 hours prior to

traveling with questions about screening policies, procedures and what to expect at the security checkpoint. In addition, passengers should contact TSA Cares if additional assistance is needed during the screening process.



Injured Service Members and Wounded Warriors

Injured and wounded service members and veterans may contact TSA Cares to request assistance with the screening process. TSA Cares will provide their travel information and type of assistance required to the departing/arriving U.S. airports.
