






## PHL's Seat Share Year-End June 2024 (Fiscal Year)

Michelin chose Philadelphia for several reasons (*Philippe Orain, Michelin Green Guide editor-in-chief*), including for it being:








The Share of PHL Passengers Coming from Counties to the North of PHL is Increasing






## 2024 Visitation Driven By Overseas Traffic – More Visits, More Nights, More Spending


