

SEPTA AIRPORT RAIL LINE SHUTTLE BUS SUBSTITUTION

Saturday-Sunday June 2-3, 2018

SEPTA's Airport Rail Line will be using shuttle bus service this weekend Saturday-Sunday, June 2-3 between Philadelphia International Airport and 30th Street Station due to an off-airport improvement project.

At the Airport, buses will pick up passengers at Zone 8 on the South Commercial Roadway between the train platforms and the baggage claims. Passengers will be dropped off on the Departures Roadway. SEPTA passengers at A-East baggage claim must walk to the Zone 8 location at B baggage claim.

Shuttle bus service will transport passengers between the Airport's baggage claim B, C, D and E and 30th Street Station beginning at approximately 5:17 AM on Saturday through 12:17 AM on Sunday, and at these same times on Sunday through Monday, June 4. No service will be available between 12:17 AM and 5:17 AM. The train will not stop at the University City Station. SEPTA will provide additional shuttle bus service between 30th Street Station and University City Station.

SEPTA Key Quick Trips, purchased from an Airport terminal prior to boarding, will be accepted for travel from the Airport on the shuttle buses. Conductors will be available at each boarding location to accept and validate the purchase.
