Frontier Airlines Announces New Service to Charleston, SC from PHL

PHILADELPHIA, PA – Frontier Airlines announced today that it will begin non-stop flights between Philadelphia International Airport (PHL) and Charleston, SC (CHS) starting in February 2018, continuing the “Ultra Low Cost Carrier’s” expansion in Philadelphia. The seasonal flights will operate three days a week.

“We are very excited that Frontier will be offering non-stop service from Philadelphia to Charleston, SC, which is a popular tourist destination,” said Airport CEO Chellie Cameron. “We are pleased that Frontier continues to bring new service to Philadelphia and look forward to even more flights to more places.”

“We are excited to expand our commitment to the Philadelphia region with more low-cost options,” said Frontier spokesperson Richard Oliver. “The community support for our Low Fares Done Right product has been great, and that’s why we’re announcing this new service to Charleston today.”

Charleston will become Frontier’s 21st non-stop destination from PHL. Twenty of the destinations, which are served with a mix of year-round and seasonal service, have been added since December 2014. Frontier is the only carrier at PHL that offers non-stop flights to San Antonio, Texas; and Punta Gorda, Florida. Those flights operate seasonally.

Currently, American Airlines provides non-stop flights from PHL to Charleston, SC.

The PHL-CHS route will be served with A-320 aircraft and will operate Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.
