## Icelandair Extends Service from Philadelphia to Reykjavik

**PHILADELPHIA** – Icelandair will expand their seasonal services from Philadelphia to Reykjavik (PHL-KEF) on May 22 with four flights a week on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays until January 6, 2019.

The seasonal International service began in May 2017 and ended in late September.
